Subject: Registration for the IFAA European Field Archery Championships 2009

Hello Fellow Archers,

As most of you are aware, the IFAA European Field Archery Championships 2009 will be hosted by Wales at Tal y Coed, near Abergavenny in South Wales from 27th to 31st July 2009. This will be the first IFAA tournament to be hosted in Wales for almost 30 years and we are looking forward to welcoming you, the archers of Europe to our Principality!

We have launched a website to help you register and prepare for the tournament. The website address is:

Registration

The website includes a registration page which offers 3 different methods of registration. UK based archers can download a UK Sterling entry form and payment can be completed and posted to us via surface mail together with a cheque or postal order.

We are also offering payment via Paypal which carries a 6 Euro surcharge but which is a convenient method of payment for archers who wish to pay via the internet. Simply complete the online form and follow the instructions. We will then send you a payment invoice which will enable you to pay the fees via Paypal either by credit card or by money transfer.

You can also make payment via SWIFT or WORLD PAY bank transfer. There is a registration form on the website specifically for payment via this method. Please note that such payments must be made in Euros. The registration and banquet fees are quoted in Euros on the entry form. To register using this method, complete the form and post it to the address on the form. You will then need to calculate the amount payable and complete payment via your bank. Please note that bank charges for sending money from your account and for receipt of the money into the WFAA account are payable by the sender.

Once we have received your registration details and payment, we will list your details on the entry list which can be viewed on the website.

Accommodation

The website has a full accommodation list which includes hotels, guest houses, bed and breakfast, houses for hire, caravan and camping and youth hostels. We will also be offering camping on site for tents and caravans. Details of on-site camping will be posted on the website shortly.

Travel and Directions

The website includes directions to the EFAC venue from all major entry points in the south of the UK. The website also includes information on travelling in the UK for the benefit of mainland Europe based archers.

Tournament Information

The timetable for events, details of rounds and other arrangements can be found on the website.

Tourism and Attractions

We are aware that many of you will be taking a holiday in the UK as well as shooting the EFAC next year. We have therefore included information on Wales, and tourism links for England, Scotland and Ireland.

Archers are advised that the registration fees increase as the event draws closer so you can save money by registering as early as possible.

On behalf of the Welsh Field Archery Association, I look forward to welcoming you all to Wales in July 2009.
