Welsh Open 3D Championships - 14th - 15th June, Hawk Archers, Tal y Coed

If you have not already entered this tournament, please get your entries in as soon as possible. We have had some difficulties with organisation of tournament logistics recently because of archers booking in for tournaments at the last minute.

Shot for the first time last year, this tournament proved popular and we are expecting a bigger turnout for it this year. Round 1 is a Marked 2-shot 3D round, Round 2 is an Unmarked 3-shot 3D round.
