Subject: WFAC 2010 in Germany

My dear friends of archery,

Happy New Year to all of you, with a lot of health, luck, success and more time to enjoy archery; one of my aims for this year.

Today I want to give you some information about the WFAC 2010 in Germany, being held from the 2nd till the 6th of August 2010.

The homepage will be open the next days with pre-information about the time schedule, location, accommodations, etc. Meanwhile a WFAC Committee has been established in Germany, organizing everything before and during this Championship. There will be 5 ranges built up, plus a 14 target range for the cups, all in an outstanding landscape in the South-West of Germany.

A lot of archers in Germany and neighbored countries have shown their interest already to participate at the next WFAC 2010. For this event our aim is to welcome as much nations as possible, as you can imagine. The WFAC Committee has worked out a strategy for all of you, guaranteeing start places within a specific time period. This exclusive registration for all IFAA nations will run from the **1st of May till the 17th of July 2009**.

Please inform all your archers and members in advance and let us know your participants soon, in response to my email address. Please use the form enclosed. A payment within this time period is assumed too, for these archers registered by you, as the representative for your nation. The payment terms will follow soon and will be sent to everybody by request. After the **15th of August 2009** we will open the WFAC 2010 registration for everybody who is member of an archery association within the IFAA. From the chart enclosed you can see your reserved starting points. All numbers have been evaluated out of the results of the recent EFAC and WFAC of the last four years, counting all the participants by each nation. Some nations have not participated at one of these Championships, but have been considered appropriate. Every reserved starts not been used, will be transferred to the open registration phase starting at the 15th of August 2009.

Even Germany is limited as you can see. A new archery squad has been created and will give these top archers the first priority for registration. At the 15th of August it will be possible to register for further interested German archers as well.

Hope you agree with our system and believe me we have spent several hours to find a fair strategy for everybody. I am looking forward to receive your registrations from a lot of nations. For any questions please come back any time.
